Phase-out of the National Diploma Clothing Management and Phase-in of the Diploma in Clothing and Textile Technology

The Department of Clothing and Textile Technology has implemented the Diploma in Clothing and Textile Technology (D3CLTT and D3CLTX) in 2017 and will be phasing-out the ND Clothing Management (NDCLMN and NDCLMX) in due course.

The purpose of introducing this qualification is to align with the new Higher Education qualification sub-Framework (HEQSF) as Gazetted by the South African Department of Education on 2 August 2013. This is a requirement placed on all Higher Education institutions.

Pipeline students will be allowed a certain period to complete the National Diploma Clothing Management, after which they will be articulated into the Diploma. Students who are returning to complete their qualification will be admitted on the current National Diploma (ND) qualification if it is still offered at the time of their return. If the qualification has been phased out, they will be articulated into the Diploma (Dip) qualification.

The Diploma in Clothing and Textile Technology was implemented in January 2017.
