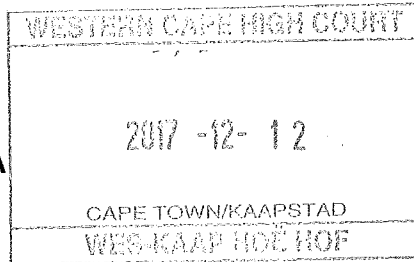

ORDER

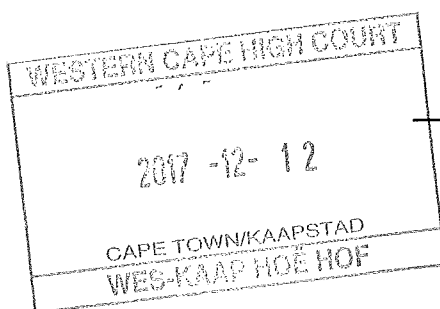
By agreement between the Applicant, the First to Fourth Respondents and the Sixth Respondent, it is ordered as follows:
