

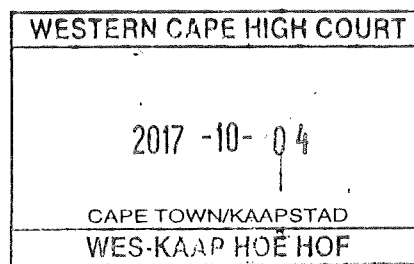

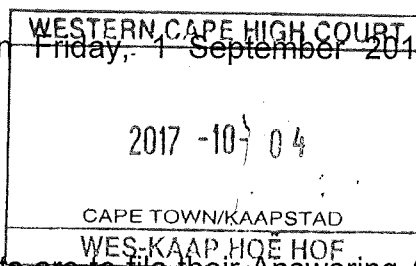

ORDER


