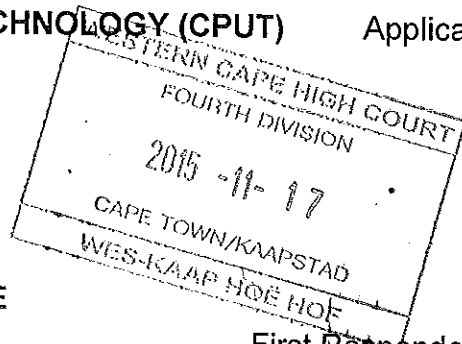

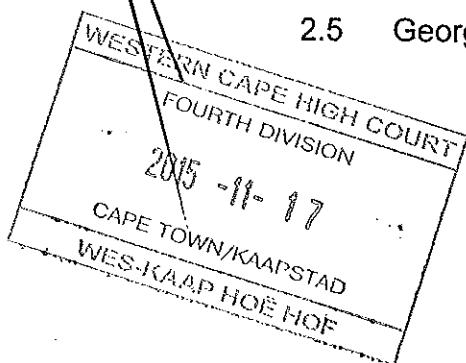

ORDER

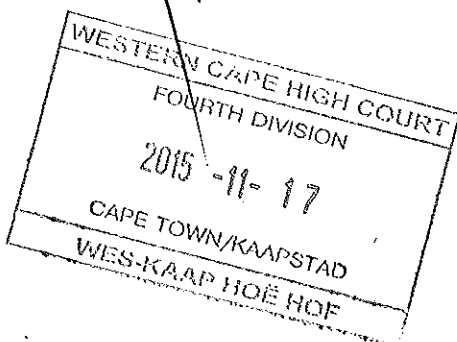

Having heard Counsel for the Applicant, a final order is granted as follows:

1. Paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of the Order granted by Mr Justice Dolamo, dated Wednesday, 21 October 2015 is made final.
  
2. Directing that the Respondents conducting unlawful activities to forthwith cease and desist from any and all unlawful activities on any of the following other CPUT campuses and/or residences:
  - 2.1 Granger Bay campus at Beach Road, Mouille Point, Granger Bay, Cape Town;
  - 2.2 Mowbray campus at Highbury Road/Main Road. Mowbray, Cape Town;
  - 2.3 Wellington campus at Jan Van Riebeeck Street, Wellington;
  - 2.4 Worcester campus at Napier Road, Worcester;
  - 2.5 George campus at 125 Mitchell Street, George.

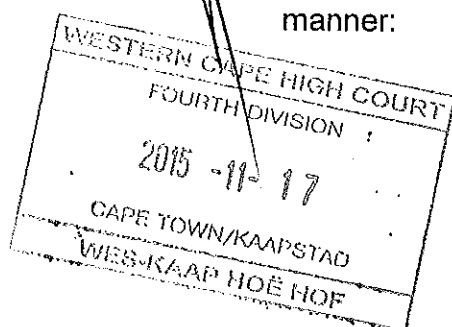


3. Directing that the Respondents conducting unlawful activities to forthwith cease and desist from any and all unlawful activities on any of the CPUT residences listed on annexure "A" hereto.
  
4. Failing the contents of paragraphs 1 and 2 above, the Sheriffs of the jurisdictions within which the CPUT campuses and residences are situate, assisted insofar as may be necessary by the South African Police Service shall be authorised and directed to immediately remove and/or arrest them.
  
5. Interdicting and restraining the Respondents conducting unlawful activities on any CPUT campus and/or residence from:
  - 5.1 Disrupting or otherwise interfering in any way with the normal activities of, including but not limited to:
    - (a) The management and administration of CPUT on all campuses and at all residences;
    - (b) All lectures and tutorials on all campuses;
    - (c) The work of the libraries on all campuses;
    - (d) The activities at all cafeterias on all campuses;
    - (e) Tests and examinations on all campuses; and
    - (f) Graduation ceremonies.

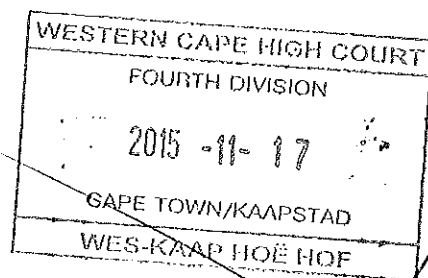


- 5.2 Barricading the entrances to any CPUT campus and/or residence, including buildings within campuses and residences;
- 5.3 Barricading any streets leading to any CPUT campus or residence;
- 5.4 Damaging or vandalising any buildings or property of CPUT on all its campuses and residences;
- 5.5 Damaging any other property, including motor vehicles, present on any CPUT campus or residence;
- 5.6 Intimidating, harassing, threatening or harming:
- (a) Any students of CPUT;
  - (b) Any employees of CPUT; or
  - (c) Any other persons present on CPUT's campuses or residences.
- 5.7 Inciting persons to conduct unlawful activities at any of CPUT's campuses or residences;

6. Service of copies of the Order granted herein shall be in the following manner:



- 6.1 By broadcasting on CPUT's Newsflash which is dispatched to all CPUT students and staff members;
  - 6.2 By posting it on CPUT's website;
  - 6.3 By posting a copy thereof at all entrances and/or noticeboards of all CPUT campuses and residences;
  - 6.4 By posting same by email and/or on facebook to the Respondents insofar as their details are known to the Applicant;
  - 6.5 By service on the hashtags #FEESMUSTFALL and #OUTSOURCING;
  - 6.6 By service by the Sheriffs of the various jurisdictions of CPUT's campuses and residences by reading it aloud by loudhailer at each campus and residence;
7. No order as to costs.


