Your on-the-job training

You are required to complete **six months of Work Integrated Learning (WIL)** in your third year.

WHAT YOU NEED

Minimum Admission Requirements

National Senior Certificate (Grade 12) with:

- English (4)
- Mathematics (2) or Mathematical Literacy (4)

Recommended:

- Business studies (4), or Economics (4)
- Life Sciences (3), or Physical Sciences (3)

If you participate in any sport as a player, coach or administrator at international/ national/ provincial level you may also be considered.

The department utilises an Admission Point Score (APS) as selection criteria once your minimum admission requirements are satisfied. You also have to score a minimum of **25** with Mathematics and **27** with Mathematical Literacy on the APS for the mainstream qualification; **23** with Mathematics and **25** with Mathematical Literacy on the Extended Curriculum Programme.

Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission. This information is subject to change based on approval and accreditation of HEQSF aligned qualifications during 2018/ 2019.

- South-African citizens with international qualifications
- Applicants with permanent residence in South Africa
- Refugee asylum seeker temporary permit/ formal recognition of refugee status in the RSA
