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#### TRAFFIC/PARKING:

The Protection Services department has received a number of complaints regarding speeding and illegal parking on our campuses. In order to ensure compliance and to respect University rules these

Traffic/Parking Rules and Regulations, as indicated on this pamphlet and on the University Web page, will be enforced 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year.

- All legal parking areas are designated by signs, painted stripes, or other pavement markings, which may indicate limited or reserve parking.
- Motorists are to yield the right-of-way to all pedestrians in a crosswalk/pedestrian crossing.
- All vehicles are to be operated with extreme caution and no more than 30 km per hour.
- Pedestrians have the right-of-way at all times.
- Traffic control such as stop signs, speed limit signs, pedestrian right-of-way and the observance of traffic lines are in effect at all times.
- Drivers are required to park within two white lines of demarcation in parking areas. A driver may be subject to fine(s) for failing to comply with any traffic rules while driving on campus.
- Vehicles with loud and excessive noise are prohibited on campus. Violators will subject to a fine.
- Parking on grass, sidewalks, streets, curbs or unimproved areas is prohibited and subject to fine. Vehicles will be allowed to park in authorised "open areas".
- Vehicles parking near a fire hydrant, blocking another vehicle, University gates and or walkways, are subject to fine and/or maybe towed away at owner's expense.
- In certain cases, Protection Services may resort to the use of a "wheel clamping mechanism" in order to immobilize an illegally parked vehicle and the violator will be subject to a fine.
- Staff and Students wanting to park on CPUT Campuses must apply for a parking disc by completing the prescribed form. The disc must be affixed and displayed on the vehicle. **On certain campuses a prescribed fee is applicable for the parking area.**
- A vehicle displaying an invalid- altered/tampered permit will be subject to a "wheel clamping mechanism", which will immobilize the vehicle, leading to the identification of the violator, who will be subject to fine.
- Unauthorized removal or an attempt of unauthorized removal of a "wheel clamping mechanism" will result in an additional R1000-00 fine.
- Any moving violation, such as speeding and excessive noise from the vehicle, will be notified via mail, when the violator is identified and may be subject to a fine.
- Vehicles parked in "NO PARKING" areas on campus will be ticketed.
- Barriers are placed for safety purposes and to be recognized as such. Evading, driving around, over or moving any barrier, gate or traffic control device unless specifically directed by a Protection Service/ Security Officer is strictly forbidden.
