- **NRF INNOVATION, DST PRIORITY RESEARCH, STUDENTS WITH DISABILITY and SCARCE SKILLS WITH A VALUE OF R60,000**
- **NRF NSFAS POSTGRADUATE PIPELINE WITH A VALUE OF R76,000**

- \* Applications must be submitted on the NRF Online Submission system at: <https://nrfs submission.nrf.ac.za>
- \* Students in the Science, Engineering and Technology (SET), Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH) fields may apply.
- \* South African citizens and South African permanent residents are eligible for these scholarships.
- \* NSFAS Pipeline supports full-time students that received NSFAS funding for their undergraduate studies.
- \* Students who already hold a qualification at this level are not eligible to apply.
- \* These scholarships may not be held concurrently with any other NRF, government-funded scholarships or with bursaries, grants or emoluments which bind recipients to enter into the service of the contract holder on completion of studies.
- \* The application must be accompanied by the following supporting documents (certified South African ID, official proof of registration, certified full academic record, proof of NSFAS if previously funded by NSFAS and a medical certificate ONLY for applicants with a disability).
