Who may apply for RPL in Emergency Care at DEMS. CPUT?

Candidates wishing to RPL into the Diploma in Emergency are (currently considering for 2021 academic year those wishing to gain access):

- Health care practitioners currently in *fulltime employment by the Western Cape Department of Health Emergency Medical Services* who has a valid/current Ambulance Emergency Assistant [AEA/ILS] Qualification), with the Health Professionals Council of South Africa.
- Minimum of two years working experience as health care practitioner.

Candidates wishing to RPL into the Bachelor of Emergency Medical Care:

- Health care practitioners holding a suitable qualification (i.e. Critical Care Assistant [CCA/ECT] qualification) with the Health Professionals Council of South Africa.
- Minimum of two years working experience as health care practitioner.
- Individuals who have a Science-related degree, with subjects such as Life Sciences/Anatomy/Physiology, Physics and Chemistry)
